How to inspect AJAX requests with Chrome tools



The Deskpro interface uses a web programming technique called AJAX to allow the pages to update dynamically without the need to refresh the .whole page

Sometimes a Deskpro support agent may ask you to inspect individual .AJAX requests to help diagnose a problem

:Here's how to do this

- .Use the Chrome web browser .1
- .Open the Deskpro interface where there's a problem .2
- . Within the Chrome menu system, select $\mathbf{More\ tools} > \mathbf{Developer\ tools}$.3



When the developer tools console opens, click on the **Network** tab, then .4 .click **XHR** below

You can now see the AJAX requests. The Deskpro agent has probably .5 told you some steps to take and a particular request to look for. Click on an individual request to see the request details, which you should copy and .send to Deskpro
