To make it easy to get started with Deskpro On-Premise, we have created ready-made virtual machine images which contain DeskPRO pre-installed on Ubuntu Linux. You can use .these to set up a working On-Premise helpdesk in 2 minutes, with no fiddly configuration

.You will need either <u>VMware</u> or <u>VirtualBox</u> virtualization software to run these images

?Having a problem with Virtualbox

If the IP address does not work when you enter it in your browser, it's likely that you need to :change the networking option in Virtualbox. Please do the following

Turn off the Virtual Machine • In Virtualbox, Right click on the DeskPRO-Helpdesk and click Settings • Click Network • Change the Attached to: NAT option to Bridge Adapter • Click OK • Relaunch the VM • .You will now be presented with a new IP address that will work •
