Answer:

This error is often caused by putting the variable names in quote marks. You don't need to put variables in quotes when writing DPQL.

Incorrect:

QUERY BUILDER

RAW DPQL

SELECT

```
'tickets.status' AS 'Status', 'tickets.id' AS 'Reference Number'
```

FROM

```
tickets
```

WHERE

Correct:

QUERY BUILDER RAW DPQL

```
SELECT
  tickets.status AS 'Status', tickets.id AS 'Reference Number'
FROM
  tickets
WHERE
```
