## What cookies does Deskpro use?

Deskpro will set a number of cookies for the Agents and End-Users of the helpdesk. These cookies are used to make the experience better and in some cases are essential to allow the proper function of the software.

The table below describes the cookies that are set and what they are used for.

| dpsid-admin<br>dpsid-agent<br>dpsid-portal          | These are session identifiers for each of the three<br>major interfaces in Deskpro. A session ID is used to<br>help store various states connected with your<br>current browser session.<br>For example, if you log in, then the session ID is<br>used to store the fact that you're logged in.<br>Without sessions, there'd be no way for Deskpro to<br>save any state as you browse around the<br>helpdesk. | Essential / Session          | Users, Agents |
| dpreme  | If you clicked "Remember Me" on the login form,<br>then a special token is saved in this cookie.<br>When you come back to the site later in a different<br>session, this token is used to automatically log you<br>in so you don't need to log in again.  | Optional / Multi-<br>session | Users, Agents |
| dp_last_lang  | This is the language you have selected on the<br>Deskpro Help Center. This is used to make the<br>experience better on multi-lingual helpdesks.   | Essential / Session          | Users         |
| _dp_csrf_token                                      | This is a special security token that gets sent with<br>any posted forms on the Help Center. This token<br>ensures a malicious attacker can't impersonate<br>your session or trick you into submitting forms that<br>you didn't know about.   | Essential / Session          | Users         |
| dpv   | This is a visitor token. This helps connect a single<br>visitor through multiple sessions for things like<br>votes on articles, comments, chats, and page<br>views. For example, if someone starts a chat as a<br>guest and then comes back the next week, we use<br>this visitor token to look up their chat history to<br>show them.  | Optional / Multi-<br>session | Users, Agents |
| dpdefaultloader_assets_url,<br>dpdefaultloader_time | These are used by the Messenger widget to<br>optimize the loader, to allow the Messenger widget<br>to load faster after the first time it was loaded.   | Optional/Multi-Session       | Users         |
