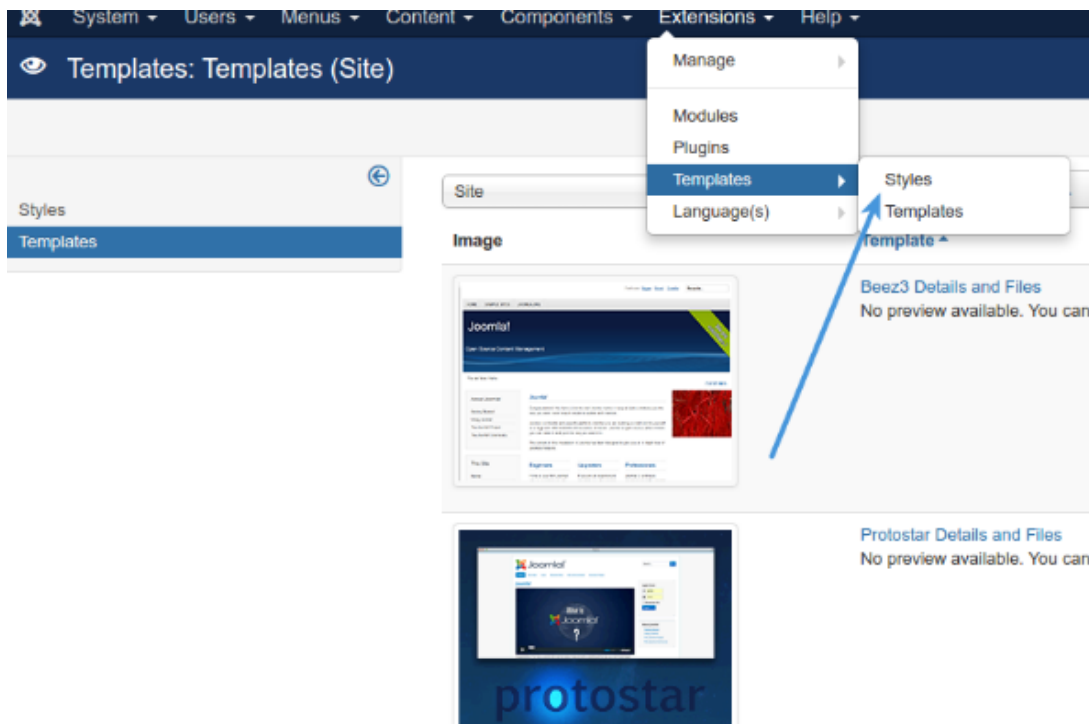


## ?How do I install the chat widget in Joomla

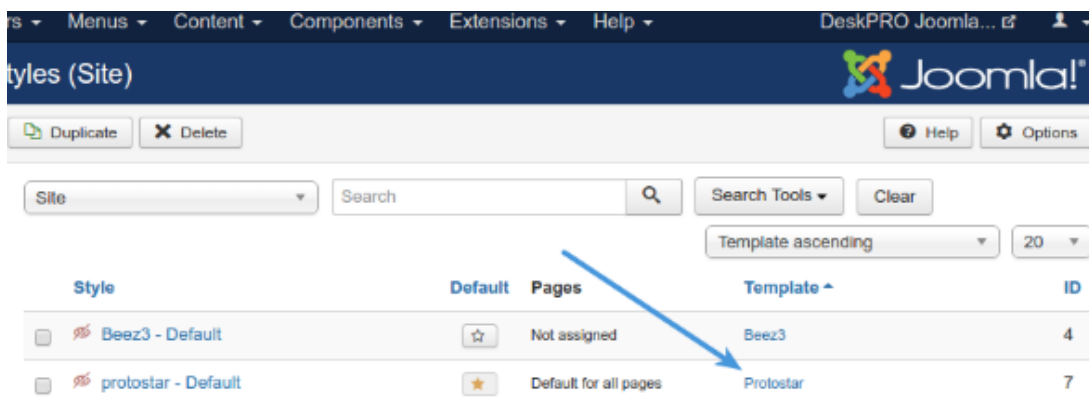

.1 Login to your Joomla account as an administrator



.2 Select "**Extensions**" > "**Templates**" > "**Styles**" from the dropdown menu at the top of the page



.3 Select your needed template e.g pick "**Default for all pages**" template, and click on its template name



.Copy the chat widget code from Deskpro under **Admin > Chat > Site Widget & Chat** .4


