When you add a task, and press the enter key, a new line is added to the task window. However, your cursor's focus does not change to the new task. In Chrome, your focus stays on the previous task, and any typing you do is appended to the task title. In IE 11, focus is lost entirely, and any typing you do triggers the associated hotkey. It would be a nice improvement to have focus move to the new task instead.
