



"Please reference a specific column" error

Question:

I'm getting an error message like this: "The following error occurred: tickets.person cannot be referenced directly. Please reference a specific column." What does this mean?

Answer:

This happens when your query is referring to a table, instead of a particular column of values within that table.

In this case, you are doing a "FROM tickets" query. You can see in the <u>tickets table</u> that you can reference tickets.person; this is not a reference to a column in the tickets table (like, say, tickets.id), but a cross-reference to a table that stores columns of data about people. This is indicated because *Person* is in italics.

For the report to work, you need to look at the <u>Person table</u> and pick a column to <u>reference</u>: for example, tickets.person.name.
