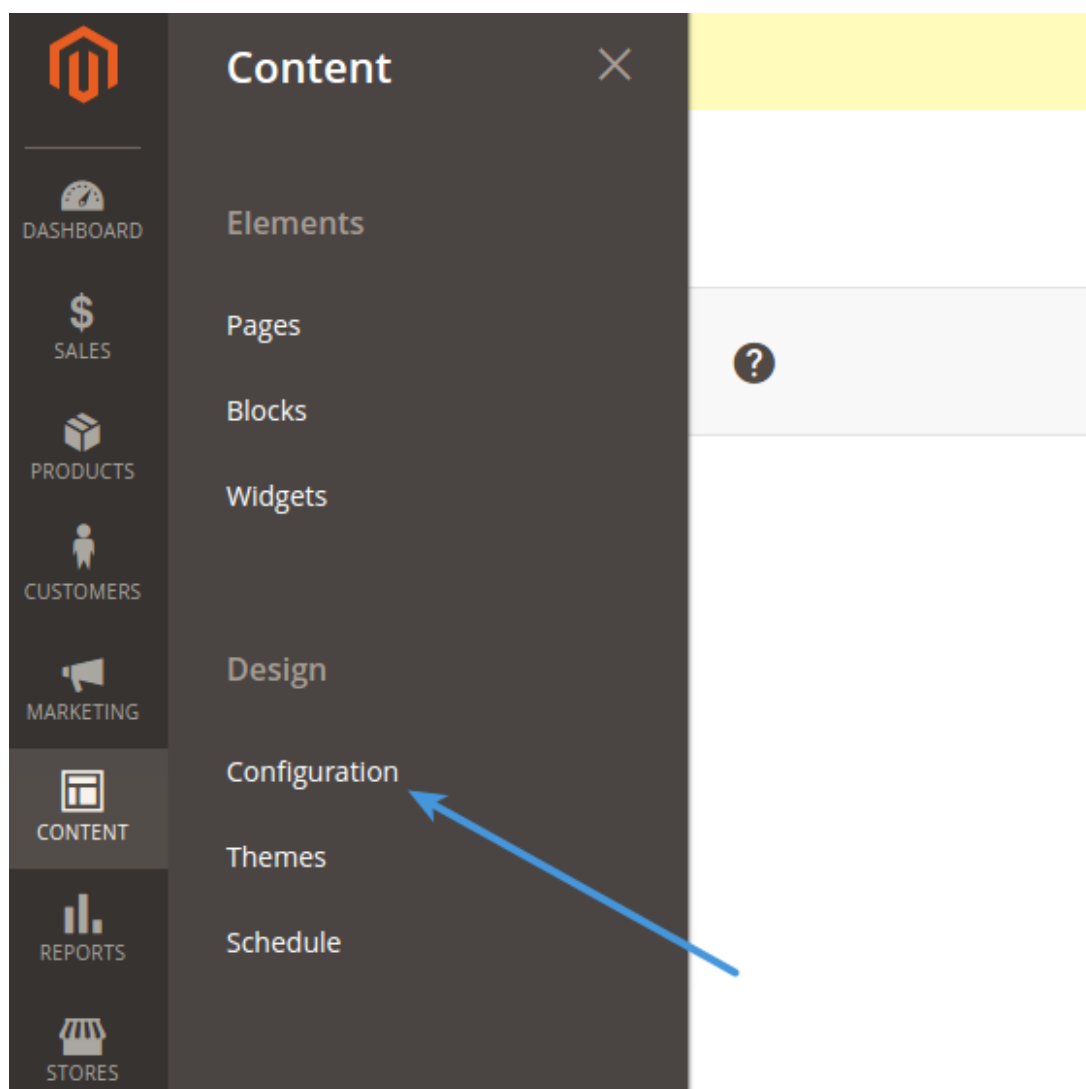


## How do I install the chat widget in Magento?

1. Sign into your Magento account as an administrator.
2. Head to the "**Content**" section on the left hand side navigation menu. Then click on "**Configuration**".



3. Find the current theme row (on a fresh installation it is applied as "Default Store View") and click "**Edit Link**".
