- To permit timely restoration of archived data in the event of a disaster or system failure as outlined in the Disaster Recovery Plan

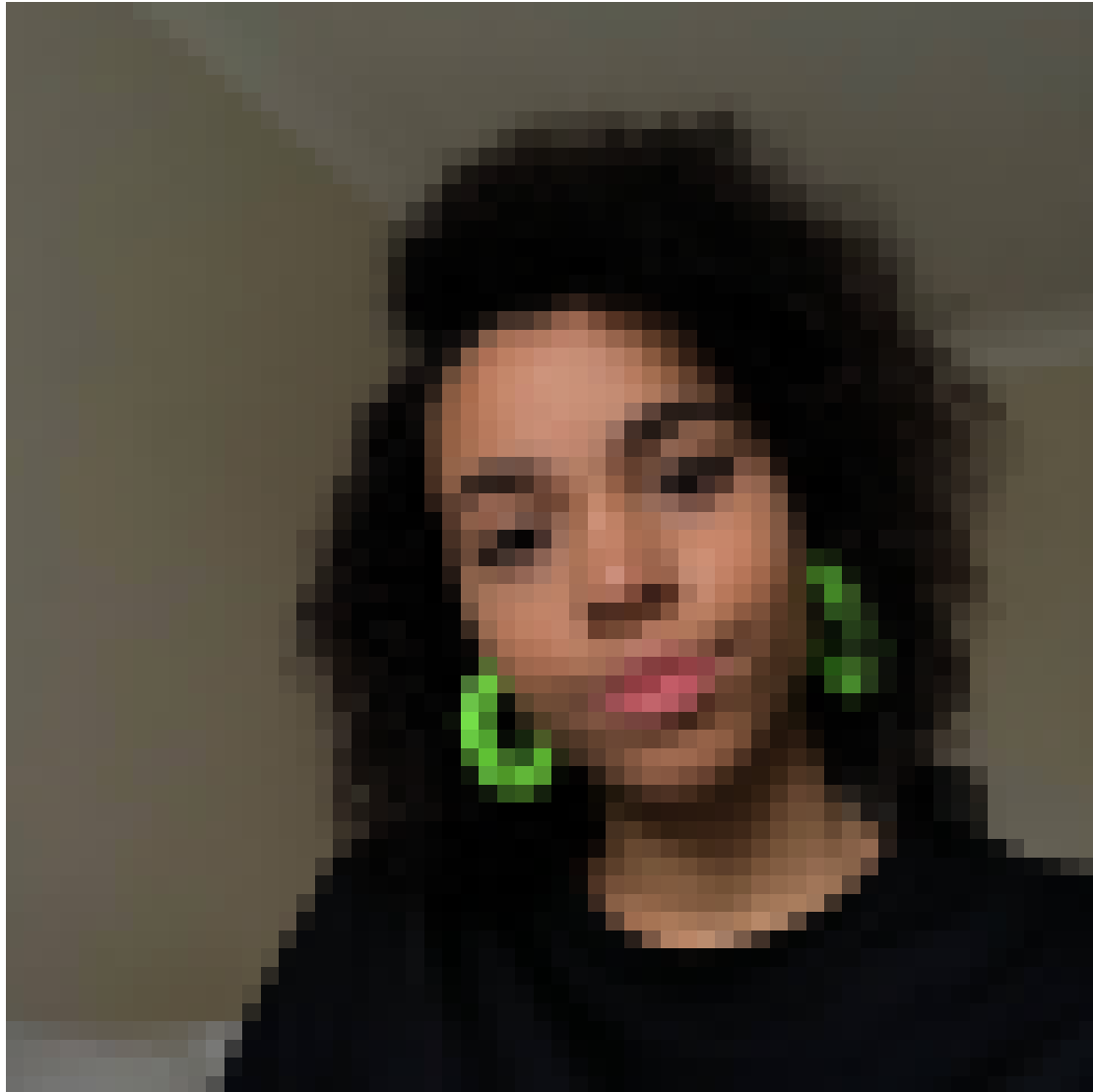
