

I'm having trouble with IMAP SSL certificate errors

Question:


We have a server with both internal and external interfaces, but the certificate used on the server is the same for both. This is creating PHP errors like this:

```
PHP Notice: Unknown: Certificate failure for example.com: Server name does not match certificate
```

We can't change the certificate setup. Is there any way to stop this error?

Answer:

Make sure you have updated to the latest Deskpro. You will see an option to **Disable certificate validation** in the settings for the email account. Enabling this for the affected IMAP account will skip the certificate check and prevent the error.
