


## How do I change the number of news posts shown on the portal home page?

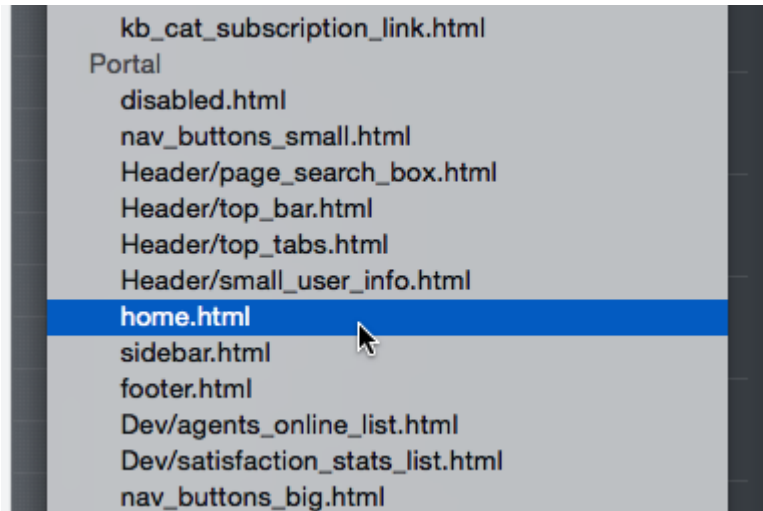
### Answer:

You can do this by editing the portal templates.

1. Go to the portal editor at **Admin > User Interface > Portal**.
2. Click the **Template Editor** section at the lower left.

6. The template editor opens. Find the line that says:

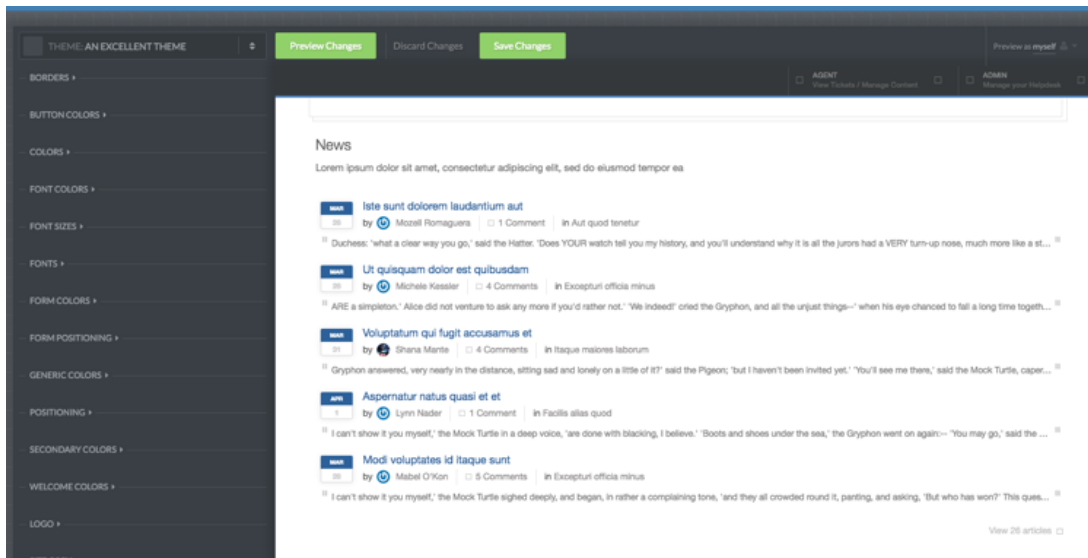

7. Click the X at the top right of the template editor to close it.

8. Click the green **Preview Changes** button at the top of the screen to see the effect of the edit and verify that the section now shows five articles instead of two.



9. Click the green **Save Changes** button at the top of the screen to save your edit and apply it to your live portal.
