

Can I use a custom domain name for the portal?

You can use any domain name you control with your Deskpro Cloud helpdesk. For example, you might want your users to go to support.yourcompany.com instead of yourcompany.deskpro.com. We refer to this as a **custom domain**.

You can use a subdomain address (such as support.yourcompany.com) or a full domain (e.g. yourcompanyhelp.com)

The first thing you need to do is create a DNS record for your domain.

Record Type:	CNAME
Host:	support.yourcompany.com.
Address:	yourcompany.deskpro.com.
TTL:	1800

You should then go to **Setup > Domain/URL Setup**, select **Use a custom URL**, and enter the domain you've set up.

If you have your own domain name, you can use it with DeskPRO. Top-level domains (such as exam Even when you use a custom domain name, your default domain still works. If your domain expires <http://a1goods.deskpro.com/admin/> (it's a good idea to write that down, just in case).

Important: You must edit your DNS to create a **CNAME** record to a1goods.deskpro.com
